Remark	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>selection will be confirmed by the end of May/beginning of June (changes would be considered in case of long term injuries, significant decrease of general performance and fitness etc.)</li> <li>selection is based on HLE results of 2024 in both the sprint and the forest disciplines in relation to team goals and expected race nature; due to Scandinavian focus and season priorities there is no reasonable possibility to get any other valuable input before the official selection deadlines</li> <li>reserves stay on the home ground, but need to be ready to jump in until the departure</li> </ul>
